

Welcome to the Walnut Senior Center

We are glad you are here! The Walnut Senior Center is a recreational facility that many area seniors enjoy and utilize for a variety of purposes. The Center offers programs and services relating to physical activity, learning, socializing, and nutrition. It is minimally staffed with City employees and volunteers who are trained to oversee a recreation program. While the Walnut Senior Center is open to the public, and welcomes all, please note that the Walnut Senior Center staff is not trained or authorized to provide specialized care to senior citizens.

To maintain the Center as a place of comfort and enjoyment, we ask that participants:

- Dress in appropriate attire, including shirts and shoes, at all times.
- Have cognitive ability as to time and space, or have a caregiver accompany them at all times.
- Be able to care for themselves (feed, toilet, etc), or have a caregiver accompany them at all times.
- Be able to navigate independently in a manner safe to themselves and others, or have a caregiver accompany them at all times.
- Refrain from any inappropriate behavior.

Inappropriate behavior includes, but is not limited to:

- Use of foul language
- Harassment or threats towards another participant or staff, or threats against property (either City or personal)
- Use of discriminating remarks
- Physical violence or threats of physical violence against person or property*

**Physical violence or threats of physical violence towards another participant, staff or property shall be cause for instant dismissal from the site pending further investigation and review.*
